







HOW TO ACCESS?







- 1. Access through <u>Library</u> <u>Website</u>.
- 2. Click EZaccess icon and log in using your UPMID.




- 3. Click letter 'S' to search SCOPUS.
- 4. Click **SCOPUS** from the journal title list.



HOW TO SEARCH JOURNAL BY SUBJECT AREA




- 5. Click **Sources** to search Subject Area.
- 6. Click Subject Area.



7. Choose your subject area.

8. Click on the **journal title** that you want, to see the source details.


Note: You can apply filter according to your needs.



9. Check the Scopus coverage years.

From the example: years 1997, 2001 and 2022 considered as not indexed in Scopus.

You can also explore more information in this section.



10. Check for discontinued coverage before you publish.

From the example: the journal coverage was discontinued starting in the year of 2008 and thus, considered as not indexed in Scopus.
