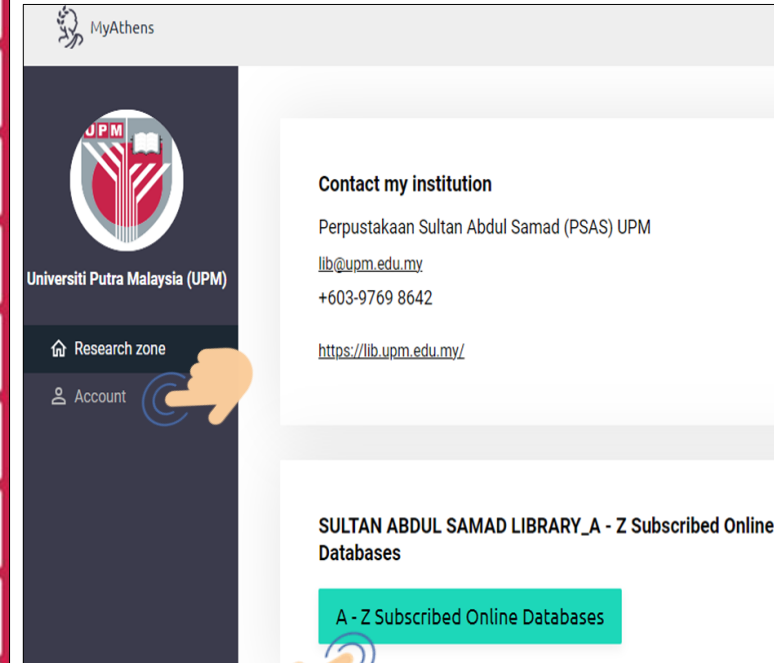


2 Scroll down and click on **OpenAthens** icon
